Description

This attractive stone-built, three-bedroom, three-storey mid-terrace is pleasantly positioned just off Fell Lane, within comfortable walking distance of local amenities and well-regarded schools.

The property has previously operated as a successful rental investment and will likely appeal to both landlord investors and first-time buyers alike.

Requiring a degree of cosmetic improvement, the accommodation offers excellent potential and briefly comprises: a spacious dining kitchen fitted with a range of wall and base units, with useful understairs storage to the rear. To the front elevation is a well-proportioned lounge, featuring a uPVC door providing access to the enclosed front garden.

To the first floor, the landing leads to a generous primary double bedroom to the front, a good-sized third bedroom to the rear, and a three-piece house bathroom fitted with a white suite and shower over bath.

A further staircase rises to the second floor, where there is a bright attic bedroom, enhanced by a Velux window.

Externally, the property benefits from on-street parking to the rear, a flagged rear yard with useful storage, and a fully enclosed front garden.
