Description

A rare opportunity to acquire the former Alnwick Methodist Church, a substantial and characterful property with 4347 square feet of internal floor space located on Chapel Lane in the heart of Alnwick town centre. Benefitting from planning permission for conversion into an impressive four-bedroom home, the approved design features a spectacular 205m² open-plan living, dining and kitchen area, enhanced by beautiful stained-glass windows that provide exceptional natural light. The building has been well maintained and offers a unique opportunity to create a distinctive principal residence, second home or holiday property.

Arranged over two floors, the property offers flexible accommodation and retains many attractive original features. In addition to its approved residential use, the building may also suit a variety of community, wellness or leisure-related purposes, subject to the necessary consents. Vendor-commissioned CGI images are available to illustrate the property's potential following conversion. total square footage is circa 4347 (205m²).

Ideally positioned within walking distance of Alnwick's shops, cafés and restaurants, the property is also close to the town's famous attractions, including Alnwick Castle and The Alnwick Garden. Excellent transport links are available via regular bus services to nearby towns and villages, while Alnmouth Railway Station, approximately three miles away, provides direct services to London King's Cross, Edinburgh Waverley and Newcastle.

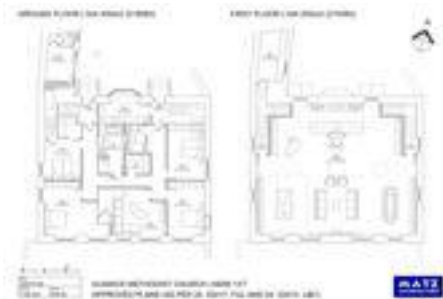

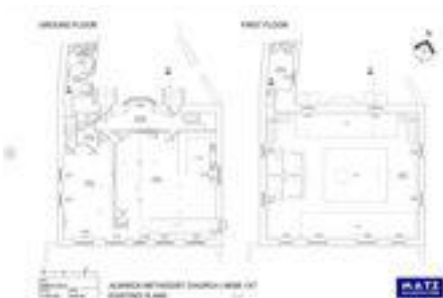
Planning Approval

Alnwick enjoys excellent transport links throughout Northumberland and beyond ideal if you want to take a trip out to one of the nearby fishing villages or beach.

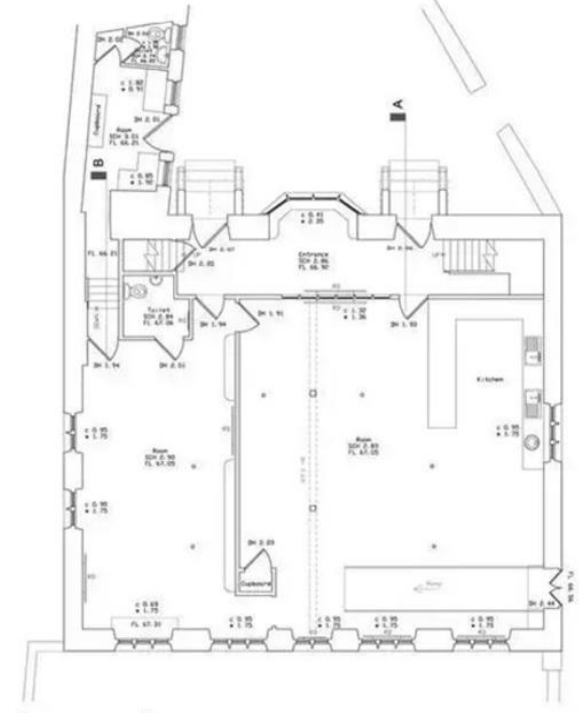

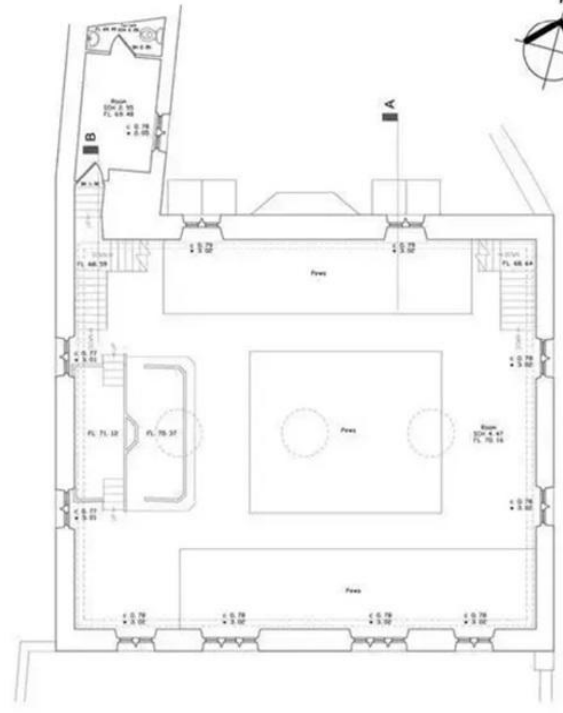
Newcastle airport is under 45 minutes drive Alnwick is located just off the A1 Dual Carriageway.
